4. Reports

City Clerk- Sent out 33 past due shut off notices. 0 on the payment plan. 7 residence shut off. Worked with Travis on getting the list of roads that have been wedged and ready for asphalt to turn over to Platte Co in hope of receiving some of the CRRSAA funding. Still handling complaints regarding the trailer park. Phil was able to complete all wedging and fill holes listed on bid. Received road sales tax distribution letter and we will be receiving \$ 18,362.64. I am having another issue with waste management. I have had at least 4 customers that I know of that has reached out to customers service for bulk pickup and are being told they no longer service the Edgerton area. I reached out to our area manager in which he said he would investigate the issue and still not got back with me.

Sewer- Sewer samples were taking; Alex has been sampling the lagoon two times a week. Baby wipes gummed up the floats at the villa lift station. The board advised Travis to send the Villas a bill for work performed per ordinance. New clutch on the lagoon pump.

Water- Water samples were taking, Water meter read for September and Went to tow meeting in Plattsburg about the chlorine burn. The clerk and I will get a PSA out to residence to let them know what to expect with the water burn.

Parks- Mowing and put in 3 hours of overtime for pioneer days.

Public Works- 18 dig rites completed, Mower maintenance. Finished pouring concrete for the sidewalks that has been tore up for water leaks. Ditches behind Nash's were dug out, road is now open and waiting on the state for the culvert. Trimmed trees that were hitting the school bus. New brakes on the snowplow truck and new tires on the ranger.

Police- Nothing to report at this time.

Emergency management- Siren did not go. Steve stated he will get with county to see why.

Joel Dudley- Travis has the residence up at Platte Ave ever receive their light pole? Travis advised no and neither has Platte Ridge Ct. He has all the work order numbers and will call Evergy again tomorrow to get an update status on the poles.

Clean up company:

Disabled cars in the yard:

Aldermen Dudley stated there is a house off Clark that is beginning to look like a junk yard. Chief Johns stated that has been like that since he has started working here. The clerk went over the ordinance that does say you can not have disabled cars in streets or on property. Chief Johns advised the board the cost to tow and store would be to much for the city. Attorney Donnelly stated she would investigate other options if any that possible could cut down the cost.

Travis asked the board if he could purchase cold patch for a total cost of \$1032.00. Mayor Harmer asked Travis about the milling we were supposed to receive. Travis advised that all will be used on Nash's Road.

Travis asked the board if they would like to bid out for a company to do the work or would rather public works do the sealant with the cost being around \$1500.00? The board held a brief discussion and decided it would be cheaper to do the work ourselves.
