Sewer- Sewer samples were taking. Alex has been sampling the lagoon two times a week. We had a high-pressure sewer main break.

Water- Water samples were taking, One water main break. We are done with the chlorine flush. We have received all electric meters.

Parks- Park lights are scheduled to be switched to L.E.D something in 2023.

Public Works- Plow truck is ready for snow. Statues at the memorial were sprayed with a clear coat varnish. 7 dig rights for the month.

Work orders-Only 2 outstanding and that is the culvert at trailer park and fire hydrants.

Police- 4 Calls for the month of November. Chief Johns also advised the board there has been no calls to dispatch regarding dogs. Amy advised the board that Edgerton Neighbors is not a city ran page and we do not go by complaints due to the fact.

Due to recent car break ins in surrounding counties Chief John advised not to leave your car unlocked and to take all valuables into the homes.

### 5. Citizen input:

Cory Lammers- Asked Travis if he was aware of the no parking signs being removed by the school. Travis stated yes, he seen that and will get them back up.

Cory also stated due to all the cars parked along Frank St, it makes it hard to see if there are any oncoming traffic. Mayor Harmed advised Cory that we will have a work session in January.

Sheryl Hanks- Asked for a update on the stop sign at Aller. Travis advised he does have a post for it now and will get that back up. Sheryl stated she loves dogs but I'm getting fed up with them running, she explained some past problems with dogs and just this morning Dumbo was chasing her cat. Sheryl stated her dog got out and was picked up, she had to go and pay to get her dog back and would like to know why this has changed. Mayor Harmer explained that first county needs to be called on dogs so there is a paper trail. They will dispatch Ian out if he is available, and if not, they will send another officer. Unfortunately, with Jackson's is no longer taken dogs which leaves us without a place to house the dogs until the owners claim them. Sheryl asked Chief Johns if Mr. Richardson talked to him about his house getting broke into twice. Chief Johns advised he has only made a report on one break in.

Ronna Moore- Can we get a speed limit sign on Clark Street? Amy advised the speed limit is 25 unless otherwise posted per city ordinance.

I have a verbal quote for the work needed at the city park. Mayor Harmed asked if she could get that down on paper and submitted over to the city.

Michael Heath-Wondering if there is anything I can do for community service for boy scouts? The board advised if something comes up they will contact him.

6. **Old business:**

Secondary line-Travis talked to Dekalb water and the last house going North toward 116 is the last connection for them. Travis advised just running a line from the old opy to the water tower would be 1.5 million dollars. The clerk advised the board there is no water grants out there that does not require a matching amount. The board agreed that we do not have the sources to put in a secondary line.

Caved sewer line- Travis stated he called to make the appointment to have the line scoped out and they missed quoted him the actual price is \$1100.00 instead of the \$900.00.
