Sewer- Sewer samples were taking. Alex has been sampling the lagoon two times a week. Moonbeam lift station running on one pump, other grinder motor is being rebuilt.

Water- Water samples were taking, Water meter read for December. We have been installing electric water meter. We had several customers that were froze up on their side of the meter.

Parks- Park lights are scheduled to be switched to led sometime in 2023.

Public Works- Plow and salted streets. 17 dig rites completed.

Police- January 10th starting at 4 am will start the switch over to encrypted radios and should be completed by February. Spoke with the owner regarding his loose dog.

Emergency management- Siren went off.

Joel Dudley- Where are we at with sending letters out to the owners of the buildings along Frank St? The abatement officer stated the letters are completed all he needs to do is bring them to city hall to get mailed out.

There is a garage a few blocks away that is about to cave in. Travis and Steve stated they will go look at it.
