City Clerk- Sent out 38 past due shut of notice. 0 on payment plan. Shut 0 residences off. Lager paperwork turned in, bid request put in paper. Sent financial to the state. Letter written in favor of Plattsburg to receive a federal appropriation that will allow them to upgrade the water system and not pass the cost on to others. Turned in the corrected ordinance to the city clerk, assessors, and zoning for William's annexation, also picked up the plot map. 2 dangerous building letters sent out certified.

Sewer- Sewer samples were taking. Alex has been sampling the lagoon two times a week. New tire for the irrigation.

Water- Water samples were taken. One water main broke. Water meters were read. We have got 137 electric meters in ground. Fiber has uncovered five water mains.

Parks- We are still waiting on the power company. Oil changed in the lawn mowers.

Streets- Filled potholes with cold patch.

Public Works- 89 dig rites completed for the month.

Police- Chief Johns stated there are a couple of issues that are starting to develop. He attended a free training course for the state of Mo homeland security that could open grants for him. He has contacted the owner of the trailer park and told him what needs to be done. Chief Johns stated he has a girl who is about to graduate from the police academy and will discuss with the board at that time to bring her on as a reserve.
