4. Reports

City Clerk- Sent out 36 past due shut off notices. 2 on the payment plan. (Both are caught up now) 1 residence shut off. Working with Lagers to get reporting set up. Requested the transportation sales tax.(\$36,069.64) Swore in Joel Dudley and Bill Rogers. Worked with Redgate on getting poly carts to residence that has the city provided trash service. ARPA funding that has been used reported to the department of treasury. Completed workman comp audit. 1 sunshine request filed.

Sewer- Sewer samples were taking. Alex has been sampling the lagoon two times a week. Working out the bugs in the irrigation. Mowed the lagoon. A new grinder pump was put in at moonbeam.

Water- Water samples were taken, One water main break. Water meters were read. We are still installing electric water meters. We have got 165 electric meters in the ground. Spent two days looking for a water main for a new tap. It was located wrong on the map.

Parks- Made a new ticket for the lights at the park. Mowing season has begun.

Streets- Filled potholes with cold patch. Clark street bridge was sprayed with waterproof sealant.

Public Works- 53 dig rites completed.

Police- Our judge is retiring and at this time we do not know who the new judge will be. 2 calls for the month, 1 being for inappropriate behavior and 1 for domestic.

5. **Citizen input:**

Aldermen Dudley asked if there was an ordinance on having to have a driveway. Travis advised no there is not one. All houses on Aller do have driveways and this winter I had a gentlemen upset that I plowed his vehicle in while plowing the street. Mayor Harmer stated we will postpone this matter and discuss it more at the working meeting.

Water connection at Moore's new build- Travis stated the plumbers spend two days looking for the main to tap into but the maps were wrong and the main is in a different location. They want the city to pay them for the time spent looking for the main. Aldermen Dudley stated situation happens and it is built in on the contract and, they escrow it in. Amy advised the board they were supposed to be at the last board meeting and was told again that they would have to speak to the board and did not show up for this one.
