City Admin- Sent out 20 past due letters. 4 on the payment plan. Shut 2 residence off. Attended Maccto conference. Began working on budget. Assisted in DNR inspection. Sent out business license renewal applications. Sent out the DNR'S lead service pipe letters to all customers with their water bills. The dates are wrong on the letters we have put the corrected dates on Facebook. Held trick or treat for the library kids and would like to thank Sheryl Hanks for organizing everything.

Sewer- Sewer samples were taking. Alex has been sampling the lagoon two times a week. We had the Villas lift station pumped out due to all the baby wipes.

Water samples were taking. Water meters were read. Been installing the new meters. We had the DNR drinking water inspection. Fixed two small water leaks. We are waiting on the water tower inspection. We are taking bids to get the water tower painted. We got 232 electric meters in the ground.

Parks-Bathrooms are shut down for the year. We finished up mowing for the year.

Streets- Filled potholes with cold patch. Cit down low hanging branches that were hitting the school bus.

Public Works- 19 dig rites for the month. Went to the Maccto conference.

Police- Nuisance violation letters have begun. There was an unprecedented response and a very positive back and forth with all so far. We have obtained compliance with some violations already including a potentially major traffic situation on Frank St near college. There are numerous vehicles on the property but after speaking with the property owners/ w have made some progress. Other violations on Belt Ave and Aller remain uncompleted however, recent communications with those violators are encouraging.

2 new arrest warrants were completed and filed thru the Platte Co courts.

There has been some discussion about burning tin the trailers. I have had conversations with the fire chief and public works in reference.

Traffic stops for minor violations have also yielded positive interactions.

There are free publications for the citizens from the federal trade commission and the Missouri attorney general's office about identify theft, scams, and juvenile online usage. I have also ordered copies of the Missouri sunshine law that are available.

1 report of burglary at Frank St. Subsequent investigation thru video cameras has yielded no current suspect currently.

Numerous calls of exparte violation have resulted in no arrest currently. Platte Co deputies' response time ends in the suspect already gone.
