Sewer- Sewer samples were taken. Alex has been sampling the lagoon two times a week. We have begun irrigating and discharging water from the lagoon.

Public Works- 16 dig rites on for the month. Put a new solenoid on the small mower. Put a new coil pack on the big mower. Mower maintains every Friday

Work orders- 2 new work orders completed.

Police- Provided 7-day notice to a resident on a previous violation. Contacted property owner for follow up from call for service. Increased traffic enforcement on B Hwy and Z Hwy. Responded to call for service for a missing juvenile. Contact by phone for party stranded in Edgerton and making emergency call to dispatch. Contacted city prosecutor in reference to building codes and fines for violation. Contacted Platte County sheriff office reference possible narcotic activity in city per citizen complaints. Completed search warrant school. Completed 92 of 100 training hours for reserve officer per Missouri post. Processed 2 code violations. Completed traffic grant through MARC. Awaiting award determination. Applied for and obtained grant for Narcan for the department.

Ball field insurance-Amy advised the board she has contacted Mike Keith insurance and they stated that if the party that is injured is not part of the lease agreement it would fall under the City's policy. Travis will get with the leaser to get a schedule on when the ballfield is available for public use during the contract period.

Outlet at park- Last year we had an outlet that was taken out, do we want to spend the money to get it up and running again? Mayor Harmer stated to get a cost by the meeting on the 12<sup>th</sup>.
