Review and amend the water ordinances-

Section 705.090 states the city will install all water service pipes from its mains to the meters on property. Travis would like to change that to the homeowners have to hire a licensed plumber to install the water lines and make the tap.

Motion to amend section 705.090 to have a licensed plumber install the water lines and make the tap.

Section 05.050 stated applications shall be in writing and the clerk shall prescribe the form of such application, subject to the approval of the board. Amy stated if she has to get an approved for the water user agreement then we will have new water customers waiting 30 days to have the water turned on in their name. Amy asked the board if we could remove the section to have board approval Motion to remove subject to the approval of the board.

Section 705.380 A. states the connection fee for the tension of water service to water users outside of the city limits of the city of Edgerton shall be \$600.00 which connection fee is non-refundable. Travis stated that the tapping fee is higher the \$600.00 and would like to have this omitted from the ordinance.

Section 705.380 B. States water rates for water users outside of the City limits shall be double the minimum rate. Amy stated this section would make the outside rate have to pay \$91.50 for the first thousand gallons.

Section 705.380 C states no agricultural or commercial purposes. Travis stated we should not be denying our farmer's water. The board held a discussion regards to this section.

Section 705.410 Tap fees. Travis stated the cost of water parts have gone up again and the \$1,000.00 tap fee is not covering the cost of setting that meter in. Travis would like to raise that to \$3,000.00. Attorney Dan Fowler stated he could include an CPI escalator which will allow you to change the rate annually depending on consumer cost. Joel stated we also need to remove the section that states water users shall be required to pay the cost of making the connection from the meter to the users building due to another section of the ordinances say they are responsible from the main to the meter to their buildings.

Motion to amend section 705.410 tap fee to add a CPI escalator. Remove the section that states water users shall be required to pay the cost of making the connection from the meter to the users building.
