**Sewer- Sewer samples were taken. Alex has been sampling the lagoon two times a week. I got the plug out of the villas sewer line, there was a wax ring in it. We snaked the sewer main for 800 B hwy. Had a capacitor go out of the Stanford lift station also had it PM why they were here. Had H&H cleaned out John Street lift station due to grease buildup.**

Due to Travis having computer issues he was unable to provide an exact cost of what was spent to unclog the sewer lines. The question arises who owed the line that was clogged. Travis explained the ordinances contradicts on who is responsible. Mayor Harmer asked the attorney to investigate this, and we will table the matter to the next board of aldermen meeting.

**Park grant- Mayor Harmer advised that we did receive the park grant for \$14,000.00 and we were able to bank the other \$6,200.00 for the total of \$20,200.00. Travis will work on getting the bid written up.**
