**Water reconnections- Travis would like to know if we can draw up an ordinance that if your meter is turned off for over a year you are not allowed to reconnect back to the transmission line. Attorney Fowler stated he will do some research on this matter and get back with the board.**

**Lights at walk track- Travis stated he has been working with Evergy on pricing to have lights turned back on at the walk track. It got disconnected due to Platte co having a meter that was for their fuel barrel, and our lights were hooked into that meter. Evergy stated we would have to pay for a new meter, new poles and add a line to the bill for the service. This is something that was not budgeted for and just doesn't have the extra funds. Amy stated she suggested solar lights which Travis said are on backorder right now. Aldermen Dudley stated just use the solar lights until something else can be done at a later date.**

**Levy tree work- Travis stated he needs some trees removed at the levy. It will cost \$4,000.00.**
